

## Day 1: Arrival Paro by Drukair

Our representative will meet and transfer to Thimphu the capital city which takes about an hour. Visit Memorial Chorten which was built by the Queen mother of Bhutan in 1972, Tashichhoe Dzong, Changangkha Lhakhang, Simtokha Dzong, General Post Office, Art School and Paper Factory.

Overnight at Thimphu Pedling Hotel or same grade hotel.(L/D)

## Day 2: Thimphu – Punakha via Duchula pass.

After breakfast drive to Punakha the ancient capital of Bhutan which takes about 2 and half hours via Dochula pass, 3100m which marked by 108 traditional Bhutanese style stupa. Later drive further down to the Punakha/Wangdue valley.

After lunch, visit the Punakha Dzong which built in between the male and female river and visit this Dzong you have to walk through the Bhutanese traditional bridge so called MoChu Bazam. **Overnight at Punakha Dragon Nest Resort** or same grade hotel. **(B/L/D)** 



## Day 3: Phunaka - Thimphu

After breakfast visit Khamsum Yulleuy Namgyal Chaorten. After lunch drive from Punakha - Thimphu via Dochula again, the drives take about 2 and half hours and visit mini zoo (can see National animal "Takin") and Budha point. **Overnight at Thimphu Pedling Hotel** or same grade hotel. **(B/L/D)** 

## Day 4: Thimphu - Paro

After breakfast drive back to Paro visit the Paro Dzong. Then visit the ruined Castle/fortress the Drukgyel Dzong which was built in 1649 to commemorate the victory over Tibetan invasion but unfortunately it caught fire in 1951 and whole building almost burn to the ground and now just ruins only. Later visit of Kichu Lhakhang built by the Tibetan King Songsem Gampo in 7th century to pin down the evil spirit who was trying to destroy the Buddhist monuments which were built by Tibetan king in Tibet.

Overnight at Paro Drukchen Hotel or same grade hotel. (B/L/D)



## Day 5: Paro sightseeing including hike to Tiger's Nest Monastery.

After breakfast, drive north of Paro valley for 30mins and start hiking to Taksang, (Tiger's Nest) the most important monastery in the country and also the main highlight in the world where several pilgrims are attracted by this monastery and do visit in this days. The hike takes about 5-6hours for round trip and visit inside the temple than later hike back downhill for lunch in cafeteria. Later free time at down town. **Overnight at Paro Drukchen Hotel** or same grade hotel. **(B/L/D)** 

#### Day 6: Drop to Paro airport for Bangkok flight. (B)
