#### **Avenue of Stars**

The Avenue of Stars honors the film greats of Hong Kong. Visitors can walk amongst the stars on the walk of fame. The avenue also features sculptures, movie industry milestones, souvenirs of sales, incredible views of Hong Kong famous

#### **Ngong Ping Cable Car**
