ZONE 5

OPEN OCEAN

Seen through the planet's largest window to the ocean, this magical realm is home to gentle giants of the sea including the leopard shark, goliath groupers, Napoleon wrasses and a never-before-seen squadron of magnificent manta rays.

ZONE 4

OCEAN JOURNEY

Discover the athletic prowess of the Indo-Pacific bottlenose dolphins, the hypnotic intrigue of schools of fish swimming in unison, the cool marine life in the cold water habitats and the pulsating dances of the sea jellies.



ZONE 3

BAY OF BENGAL AND LACCADIVE SEA

The Sundarbans Mangrove is home to a myriad of endangered plants and mangrove inhabitants. Look out for other jewels of the coral reef and unique fish species found in the Laccadive Sea.

ARABIAN GULF AND ARABIAN SEA

The Arabian Sea and the Arabian Gulf make up one of the largest marine sanctuaries in the world. Encounter unusual semi-aquatic creatures from the rocky shores of the Gulf to the living colours of the overhanging coral reef.



ZONE 7

RED SEA

The Red Sea, the world's northernmost tropical sea, is home to coral reefs – often called the 'rainforest of the seas', that harbour a vast array of marine life. Coral reefs are truly one of the most beautiful ecosystems in the world!



ZONE 8

EAST AFRICA

The two freshwater lake habitats of Africa, Lake Victoria and Lake Tanganyika, are home to an amazing diversity of fish as well as the predatory African tigerfish, the piranhas of Africa!



ZONE 9

SOUTH CHINA SEA

See the lionfish display their poisonous outstretched barbs. Spot a variety of lobsters amongst the rubble and the squirrelfish hiding under the reef overhang.

ZONE 10

SHARK SEAS

Be transported into the marine habitat of majestic predators. See endangered species like the scalloped hammerhead shark, the powerful silvertip shark and the sandbar shark together for the very first time.

The built-in clear dome lets your kids crawl in and pop their heads up for an up-close view.
